A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
OCEANO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DESIGNATING GENERAL MANAGER
AND/OR THE FIVE CITIES FIRE AUTHORTY WITH THE AUTHORIZTION NECESSARY
TO COORDINATE THE REMOVAL AND TOWING OF UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES
PARKED IN THE DISTRICT PARKING LOT

WHEREAS, the Oceano Community Services District ("District") offices are located at 1655 Front Street, Oceano, CA 93445 ("District Office"); and

WHEREAS, the District provides parking for its employees, guests, and customers in parking lots located in the front and back of the District Office; and

WHEREAS, Station 3 of the Five Cities Fire Authority is also located on District property and utilizes the District parking lot for its employees, customers, and guests; and

WHEREAS, unauthorized vehicles have been parking in the District parking lot to the disturbance of the District and the Five Cities Authority; and

WHEREAS, for the benefit of public health and safety and to preserve and maintain District property, the District desires to authorize the District General Manager and/or the Five Cities Fire Authority with powers necessary to direct the removal and towing of unauthorized vehicles from District property; and

WHEREAS, during regular District business hours, the District General Manager will have the authority to direct the removal and towing of unauthorized vehicles from District property; and

WHEREAS, when the District offices are closed, the on-site officer in command for the Five Cities Fire Authority will have the authority to direct the removal and towing of unauthorized vehicles from District property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Oceano Community Services District as follows:

- 1. District Staff is directed to install "No Parking" signs at all entrances of the District parking lot in compliance with the California Vehicle Code and to execute any written agreements necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Resolution.
- 2. During regular District business hours, the District General Manager will have the authority to direct the removal and towing of unauthorized vehicles from District property.
- 3. When the District offices are closed, the on-site officer in command for the Five Cities Fire Authority will have the authority to direct the removal and towing of unauthorized vehicles from District property.
